AVAILABLE POSITIONS

The following positions are available during the day. Please note that although we try to place volunteers in their area of choice and will be filled on a first come, first served basis. If we are unable to slot you in where you would like, don't worry we'll contact you before we slot you into another spot. If you just want to help out but are not fussy on how you help, don't select any of the highlighted positions and we'll know you're up for anything!

SET UP AND STRIKE CREW

Join our efforts to prepare for Scotiabank AIDS Walk and complete various tasks under the direction of the Logistics Team Leader during the WALK. This volunteer position(s) is great for people that want to help out but also want to walk!

PARKING PATROL • GREETERS

Be the first face that participants see the morning of AIDSwalk Guelph! Greet participants as they arrive at the event and direct them to where they can park (if needed).

MARSHALLS

You will be responsible for monitoring walkers and directing pedestrian traffic along the route.

This enthusiastic group of volunteers will cheer on participants as they walk. A cheerful and energetic personality is a must. Create your own signage to take with you on the route over at the Sign Making Table (this is not mandatory).

Volunteers with First Aid Certification would be a great asset to this team. Monitor Volunteers must be at least 16 years old or accompanied by an adult.

INFORMATION TABLE

Information table will be check in for all volunteers, lost and found, answer questions about the event and educate participants about ARCH and other work that we do. This will be the central location for all volunteers to check-in, get their shirts etc. Responsibilities may overlap so it will be beneficial that all volunteers be familiar with all aspects of the event.

SIGN MAKING TABLE

Help keep crafty stuff organized. Supervise children if using supplies.

KIDZONE / SIGN MAKING (Pending)

Crafty? Why not hang out at the Sign Making Table and help keep things tidy and organized.

REGISTRATION

Register participants for the walk and reconcile pledges. Specific skills and experience in financial management, money handling, and customer service are an asset.

You must be friendly, outgoing, detail-oriented, and have a valid photo ID. Volunteers must be over the age of 18.

PHOTOGRAPHER

Capture all of the special moments of the event you're your camera and assist with photographing throughout the day. Perfect for those with skills & experience in event or group photography.

PHOTOGRAPHER'S ASSISANT

Help the photographer by getting subjects, groups or other activities ready for the photographer.

FLOAT ERS / RUNNERS

Organizing an event is difficult and there are always last minute details / supplies that may be required. Also can cover volunteer breaks at tables.

SOUND TECHNICIAN

Ability to run basic sound system for Speakers and Entertainment.
